| <p>The Phoenix Health Inequalities Project is a community outreach project, which seeks to empower local residents to take a more active part in developing Hillfields as a healthy and positive place in which to live and work. The project will work with residents, existing community organisations and partnerships and will particularly target minority and excluded sections of the community. To:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • enable and encourage greater participation by local residents in decisions which affect their health and wellbeing, including the identification and realisation of community health needs and the development of appropriate services and facilities to meet them; • facilitate links between local communities and service providers (including GPs, the Primary Care Trust, local government and other government and voluntary sector providers); • improve access by local residents to information and services which will enable them to adopt healthy lifestyles; • support the development of community health improvement initiatives; • increase access to skills training, leisure activities and facilities which support active and positive lifestyles; • Develop self esteem as a means of empowering people to make life style decisions leading to a better and more active role in the community and work place. <p>The project will work with existing community partnerships and seek to increase the level of interaction and cohesion between different sectors of the Hillfields community through the development of joint project activities. It will also support the work of individual organisations, particularly those set up to meet the needs of minority groups and communities new to Hillfields.</p> | | | | | | | | |

| <p>The HDO will be employed by Coventry City Council, Health Development Unit and will be managed by the Senior Health Development Officer (Health Inequalities). Support will be provided by the Hillfields Area Co-ordination staff with regard to health and safety on a routine daily basis.</p> <p>The Health Development Officer will also be accountable to the Hillfields Health Action Group which is made up of local residents and professionals representing organisations working on health and life style related issues in Hillfields. The organisations represented include WATCH, Phoenix Area Coordination, the Primary Care Trust; the Coventry Refugee Centre; Red Cross; Coventry Carers Support Project; Osaba Women's Centre; The Anchor Centre; health visitors; dentists; General Practitioners; pharmacies.
